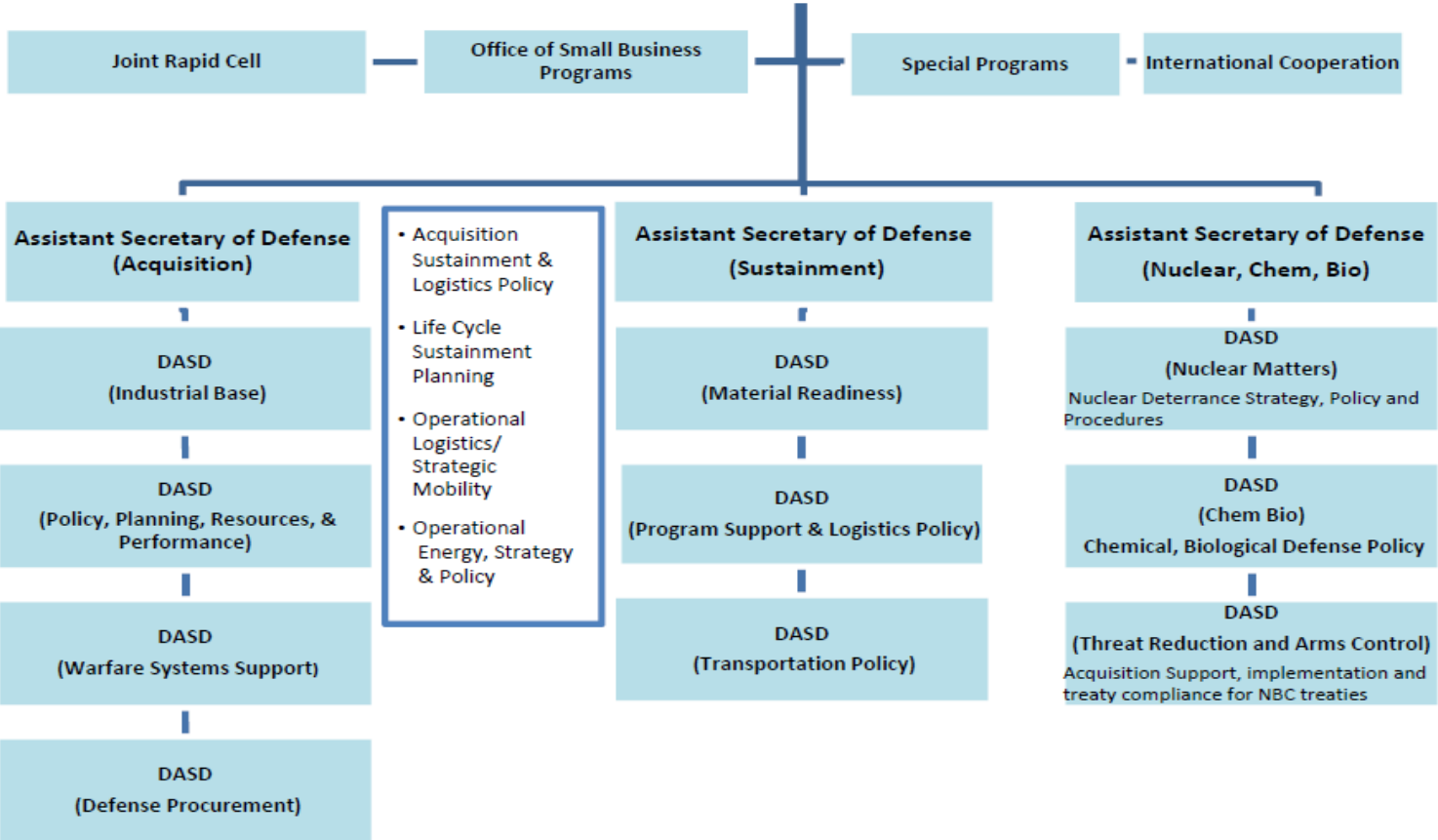

# Procurement Administrative Lead Time (PALT)

**We need to remarkably decrease the time it takes to get weapons systems and services on contract while respecting each taxpayer dollar we spend**

- **Train the workforce -  
Contracting & Small Business Professionals**
- **Creating an online real time acquisition streamlining tool**
- **Empowering teams to take measured risk**
- **Having flexibility in the amounts of certified cost and pricing data needed**
- **Creating a PALT tracking tool**



# Regulatory Reform Task Force (RRTF)

- **In accordance with Executive Order 13777, “Enforcing the Regulatory Reform Agenda,” the DoD Regulatory Reform Task Force is doing a comprehensive review of solicitation provisions and contract clauses to determine if any are candidates for repeal, replacement, or modification**
- **As of April 18, 2018, the DFARS Subgroup has made recommendations on 161 of the 354 DFARS solicitation provisions and contract clauses**
- **The DoD RRTF has dispositioned 140 of the DFARS Subgroup recommendations**

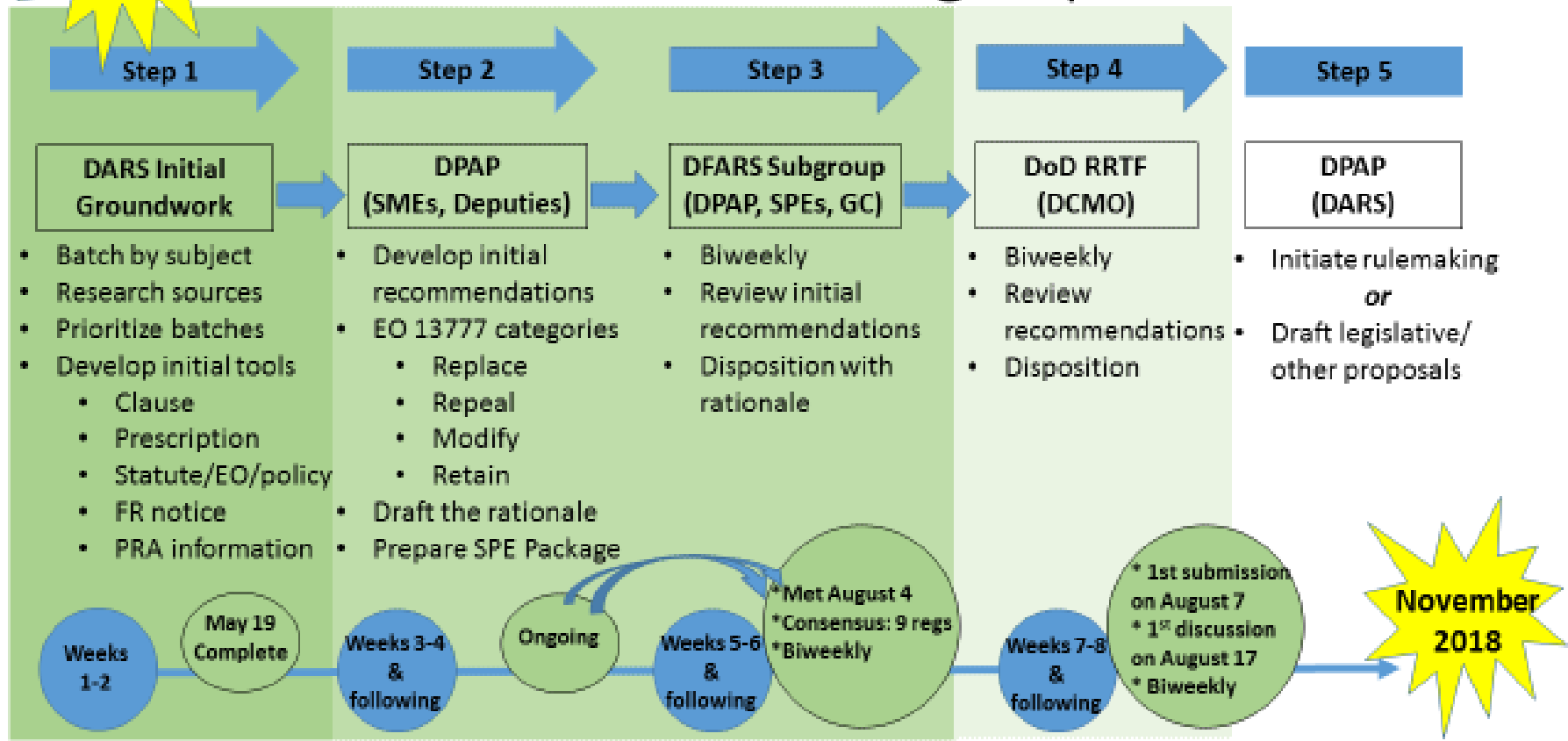

# Peer Reviews

- **OSD conducts peer reviews for solicitations and contracts on high-dollar and special interest acquisitions to advise, assist, and enable the military departments and agencies to execute their work efficiently and effectively**
- **The reviews are primarily conducted by a contracting Senior Executive Service (SES) together with Program Management and Senior Engineers**
- **DOD Instruction 5000.74 includes OSBP in the review of Service Contracts so DPAP includes a Small Business professional in the applicable peer reviews**
