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
Businesses Win \$16.5 Billion in Government Contracts, Thanks to Procurement Technical Assistance Centers (PTACs)

- PTAP = Procurement Technical Assistance Program
 - Established by DOD / DLA, 1985
 - Mission: "improve & retain stable industrial supply base" by ensuring viability and preparedness of US businesses to win & perform government contracts
 - Dept of Defense
 - Federal Civilian
 - State & Local & other public sector entities
 - 98 PTACs in the US, Guam, PR, with 300 local offices
 - Over 41,350 businesses trained and counseled.
 - Over 87,000 government contracts won.
 - 95% small businesses.



Virginia PTAP


- 51% of all jurisdictions (cities & counties)
