
August Black Business Awarenes Month

Black Business Month is celebrated in August — it's a time to acknowledge and appreciate blackowned businesses across the nation and all that they represent in the country's continual striving for diversity and equality. When we celebrate the contribution of black business owners and entrepreneurs, it pays homage to them and their legacies, especially since celebrating this month recognizes the importance of black-owned businesses when it comes to contributing to the nation's economy as well. Approximately 10% of all American businesses are black-owned, and about 30% of minority owned businesses are black business owners. The primary sectors in which black-owned businesses operate include health care, social work, repair and maintenance, beauty salons, restaurants, and more. Black businesses across the country are booming and on the rise, with Washington D.C. having the highest ratio of black-owned businesses, a whopping 28%.

Defense Federal Acquisition Regulation Supplement: Reauthorization and Improvement of Mentor-Protégé Program (DFARS Case 2020-D009)

DoD is issuing a final rule amending the Defense Federal Acquisition Regulation Supplement (DFARS) to implement a section of the National Defense Authorization Act for Fiscal Year 2020 that reauthorizes and modifies the DoD Mentor-Protégé Program which goes into effect Monday, October 24, 2022.

The rule will benefit small business concerns by extending the opportunity to enter into DoD mentorprotégé agreements. In addition, the eligibility of small business concerns is expanded as this rule removes prior restrictions for eligibility by aligning the size of the small business with the size standard associated with its primary North American Industry Classification System code. This rule is also expected to benefit large entities and the Government by expanding the defense industrial base.

National Defense Authorization Act Includes Provisions for Small Businesses

The provisions are aimed at boosting the ability of small businesses to compete for federally funded contracts

The U.S. House of Representatives recently passed the National Defense Authorization Act for Fiscal Year 2023 (NDAA), which is a bipartisan defense bill. It includes numerous measures to support small government contractors and boost small business participation in the procurement marketplace. The bill was received in the Senate on July 28, 2022 and placed on the Senate Legislative Calendar on August 3, 2022. No further action was taken by the Senate before it adjourned for August Recess. Both chambers are expected to return September 6. <u>Read more ></u>

Time Is Already Running Short for Congress to Pass 2023 NDAA, Spending Bills

More than seven weeks still remain until the 2023 fiscal year begins on Oct. 1, but observers of Congress are already warning that time is running out for lawmakers to pass the annual National Defense Authorization Act and appropriations bill that will fund the Pentagon before that deadline. Should Congress fail to pass those bills on time, they'll have to pass a continuing resolution to keep the federal government open, a move that keeps spending levels frozen at the previous year's levels. **Note:** Article originally ran on August 8, 2022. <u>Read more ></u>
