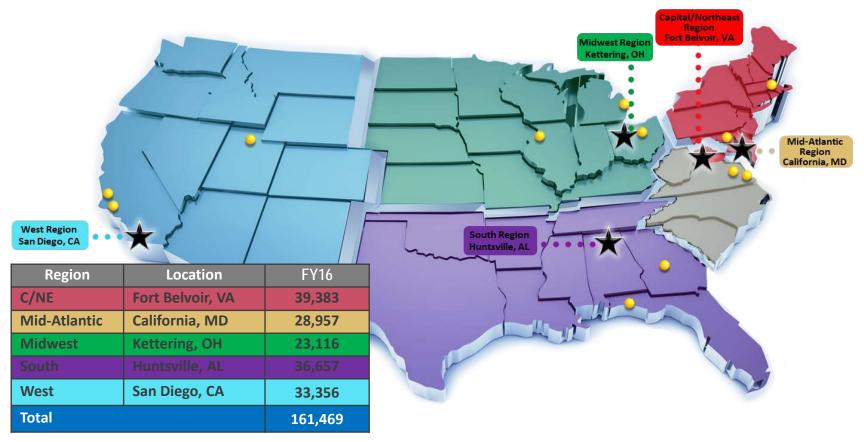

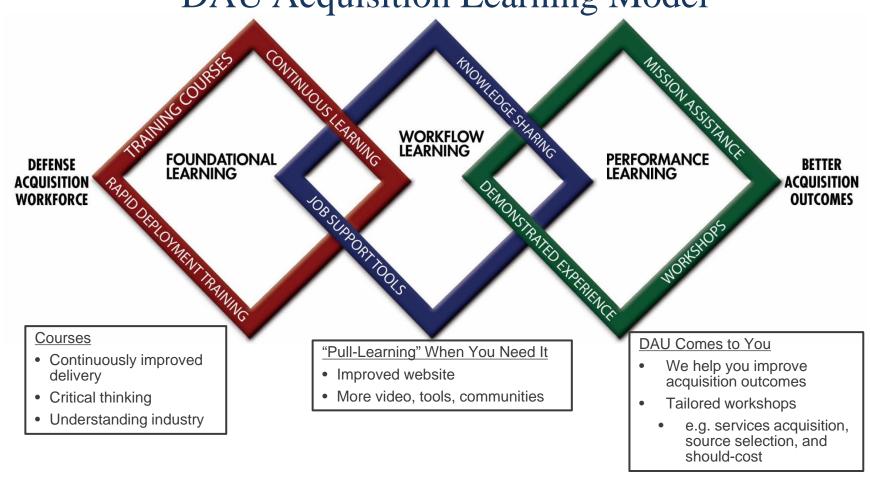

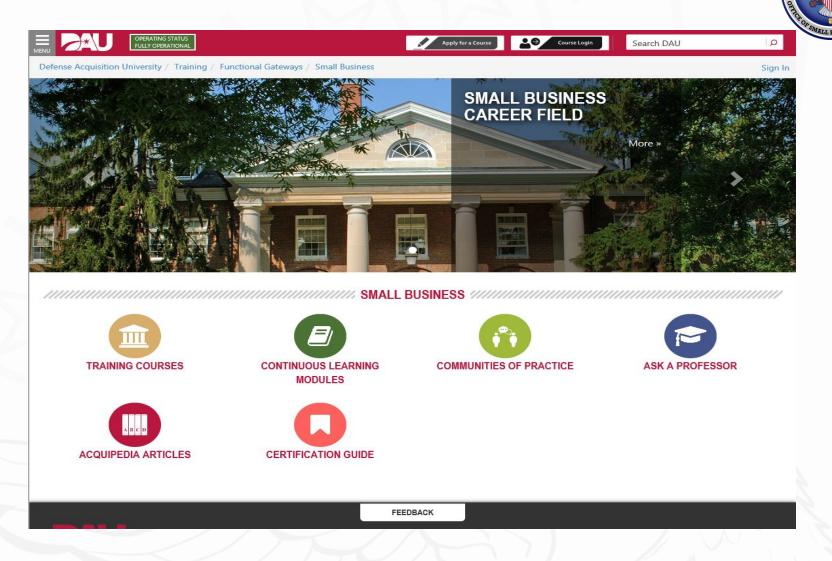


DAU Acquisition Learning Model

Additional Level I Notes



- For those new to Acquisition, it is recommended to take SBP 120 first and prior to SBP 101.
- For those with at least 2 years Acquisition experience, it is recommended to take SBP 101 first and then take SBP 110 and 120 in any order, even before SBP 102 due to limited seat availability of SBP 102.
- It is recommended CON 100 and CON 237 be taken in sequential order.

- CON 216 has a pre-req of CON 200, which has additional pre-reqs.

Priority of Enrollment



Priority 1: Defense Acquisition Workforce members who must meet position training requirements.

Priority 2: Defense Acquisition Workforce members striving to meet certification standards at a higher level than required within their assigned career field/path.

Priority 3: Defense Acquisition Workforce members striving to meet crossfunctional certification standards.

Priority 4: DoD Personnel. Components and agencies may subdivide these categories or assign additional priorities below priority 3 as may be required to meet their unique needs.

Priority 9: All others. This includes industry and other government agencies.

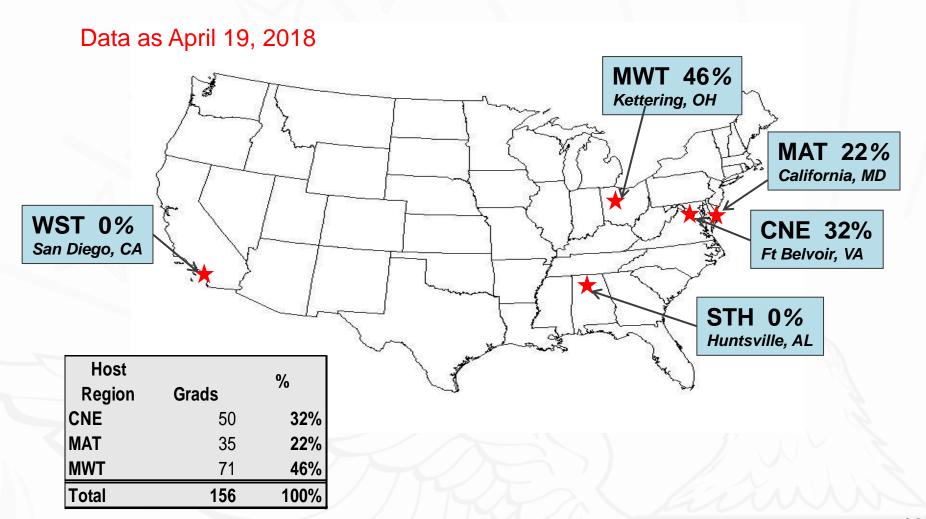
